In summary the CABE grant can be used to pay for project resources and materials, the costs of other providers such as architects or artists, travel, supply cover or other equipment specifically to aid the delivery of the project. Applications must be submitted under one of the following five categories:

Sustaining our cities and buildings

Projects that engage young people in thinking about how buildings and places can be adapted and better designed to reduce their negative impact on the planet.

Transforming school environments

Projects that take advantage of a new school build, refurbishment or school grounds project to help pupils to think about good design and participate in changes to their school environment.

Learning about local places

Projects that use the rich source of learning opportunities right on our doorstep through visits, on-site explorations and creative work.

Participating in community projects

Projects that make the most of wider learning opportunities and extend young people's voice and presence in their community.

Engaging with the design process

Projects which transform pupils understanding of the design process and opens their eyes to new ways of looking, thinking and doing.

The deadline for applications is 5pm on Monday 9 November 2009.
